



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

(pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016)

In accordance with the provisions of art. 13 of the EU Regulation 679/2016, we hereby wish to inform you as follows:

Purpose of personal data processing:

Your personal data, freely communicated and collected as a result of the activity carried out by “Prosecco Cycling Sporting Amateurish Association”, will be processed lawfully and properly for the following purposes:

- Administrative-accounting purposes for the management of existing working or contractual relationship
- Other purposes are related to promotional and marketing activities (including newsletters and telephone contacts).

The data processed (which may be of a common, identifying, sensitive or judicial nature) are updated, relevant, complete and not excessive in relation to the purposes listed above, for which they are collected and subsequently processed.

Processing methods:

Your data will be treated, in a secure and confidential manner, through the following methods: collected from the concerned person, collected and registered for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes and used in further processing operations in terms compatible with these purposes; data processing is implemented with the aid of electronic and automated tools (personal data are collected electronically, directly from the concerned person).

Legal framework of the processing:

The processing of your personal data is based on the signing of the contract, the proposal or the offer submitted by us to you or vice versa. On your request for information or offer about our products or services.

Legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller:

The legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller in the processing of data are based on respecting and honoring the contractual obligations signed between the parties or complying with their requests. Pursuant to art. 6, the lawfulness of the processing is based on the express consent expressed by the concerned person, documented in writing.

Compulsory or optional nature of data provision and consequence of any refusal

The nature of the provision of administrative and accounting data on your part is mandatory for the Data Controller to provide the requested services. In case of refusal, it will therefore be impossible to proceed with the relationship and the Data Controller will not be able to fulfill the contractual obligations.

The provision of data for advertising and information purposes is not mandatory and derives from the explicit consent that may be expressed.

Communication of data to third parties:

Your personal data will be processed by the Data Controller, by Data Processors appointed by him and by the strictly authorized processing officers. They can be communicated to institutional bodies in case of their request.

Your data may be communicated as a result of inspections or audits (if requested) to all the inspection bodies responsible for inspections and audits regarding compliance with legal obligations.

Your data may also be communicated to companies/professional firms that provide assistance, advice or collaboration to the data controller, in accounting, administrative, tax, legal and financial matters, to public administrations for the performance of institutional functions within the limits established by law or by regulations and to third-party service providers who need the communication for the performance of the services covered by the contract. Your personal data will not be disseminated in any way.

Storage times:

Your personal data will be stored for 10 (ten) years, from termination of the relationship or until the commercial purposes are achieved.

Existence of automated decision-making process:

There is not an automated decision-making process.

Intention of the Data Controller:

The Data Controller will not transfer your personal data to a third country or to an international organization.

Data Controller and Data Processor:

The data controller is the “Prosecco Cycling Sporting Amateurish Association”, with registered office in Via Cimavilla n. 24 - 31050 Miane - Combai (TV), in the person of its Legal Representative Ms. Gisella Mattiola Amabile. Ms. Gisella Mattiola Amabile is the Data Processor appointed for the reply to the data subject in case of exercise of his or her rights.

The data subject may at any time exercise his or her rights, established by art. 15, whose full text is shown below.

Art. 15 EU Regulation 679/2016 - Right of access to personal data and other rights:

The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning him or her even if they are not yet registered, and their communication in intelligible form. The data subject has the right to obtain an indication of the origin of personal data; purposes and methods of the processing; the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments; the identification details of the data controller, of the person in charge and the appointed representative pursuant to art. 5 paragraph 2; the subjects or categories of subjects to whom his or her personal data may be communicated or who can learn about them as appointed representatives in the national territory, or as managers or appointees. The data subject has the right to obtain: the updating, rectification, or, when interested, the integration of data; the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part, for legitimate reasons the processing of personal data concerning him or her, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection; to the processing of personal data concerning him or her for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market surveys or commercial communication. In particular, the data subject may at any time request the Data Controller to access personal data and to rectify or cancel them or limit their processing or to oppose their processing, in addition to the right to data portability. The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to the revocation and has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
